

Adriano Amaral, Beatrice Lozza

in conversation: 1-31 July 2013

A one-night-only viewing following a month-long residency in the gallery by two students at mid-point of the MA at Royal College of Art, London.

Adriano Amaral (b. 1982; Brazil) and Beatrice Lozza (b. 1977; South Africa) live and work in London. Recent exhibitions include *WIP Show*, Royal College of Art, London (2013); *Back Fill*, Royal College of Art, London (2013). Currently, Amaral takes part in *Open Cube* curated by Adriano Pedrosa, White Cube, London.

Summer residency enters its third cycle – two London-based MA students continue a developing conversation with the gallery acting as studio space for 5 weeks. Previous residents include *Oscar Murillo, Marianne Spurr / Boomerang* (2011); *Ed Fornieles, Sam Williams / PAINTINGSCULPTURELAND* (2010).
